<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The house officer performs and documents history and physical exam.(1,3,4) • Performs differential diagnosis (1,2) • Develops and documents pre and post op care (1,2,3) • Obtains and documents informed consent (1,2,3,4,5) • Dictates Operative Note (1,2,3,4) • Dictates discharge summary (1,2,3,4,6) • Orders diagnostic test (s) (1,2,3,4,5) • Orders medications (1,2,3,4,5,6) • Orders and obtains consults (1,2,3,4,5) • Orders work-ups for Uveitis Orbit disorders.
